

#### **Our Cancellation Notice**

Customers will receive a full refund with 48 hours or more notice of cancellation. Any cancellation with less than 48 hours notice will receive a 50% refund. Customers will also receive a full refund in case of operator cancellation due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances (i.e. lack of participation) Weather conditions are decided at the boat harbor.

## Where do you sail from and where do you go?

Experience Smith Island programs depart and arrive at Somers Cove Marina.

Parking: Parking is free at the marina in the areas marked with white lines. Dockside: Board the Circuit Rider boat at Pier B6 at Somers Cove Marina

## Timing:

The boat leaves Somers Cove Marina in Crisfield, Maryland at 10:30 am and sails to three communities on Smith Island in the Chesapeake Bay. The boat returns at approximately 4:30 pm the same day.

There is a one hour boat ride to Tylerton, arriving at approximately 11:30. You will have 90 minutes to explore this charming maritime community.

We will then depart Tylerton and travel leisurely through the town of Rhodes Point and then on to the docks at Ewell where you will have two hours to explore the community.

We depart Ewell at 3:30 and return to Somers Cove Marina at approximately 4:30.

## What do I bring?

Dress appropriately for the weather. Keep in mind that it will be cooler on the water. Consider bringing a camera, water, sunblock, a hat, and bug spray. There are restaurants and shops for you to buy food, drinks, and other necessities but keep in mind, some businesses do not take credit cards, so make sure you bring cash.

## How many passengers/participants can your programs accommodate?

Our programs are designed to be intimate experiences. Along with our vessel capacity, we limit our experiences to 6 people.

## When do your tours run during the year?

- April-May: Friday and Saturday, or by appointment
- Memorial Day-Labor Day: Wednesday-Saturday, or by appointment
- September-October: Friday and Saturday, or by appointment

Unfortunately the tour is not designed for people with mobility issues. Our vessel can't accommodate wheelchairs and mobility scooters. Once on the island, some walking is necessary to truly explore and appreciate the island's landscapes.

# Are there accommodations for shellfish allergies or food allergies?

We offer a crab cake lunch with the tour, but can accommodate substitutions with at least one day's advance notice.

## Should visitors expect swimming on the island, or to get wet?

No, there will not be an opportunity to get wet (unless it rains—and fingers crossed, it won't!).

#### Does Circuit Rider have a cabin if it is inclement?

The vessel has an enclosed cabin and a hard top canopy with side curtains. There is also a bathroom on the boat.

#### Is there cell service on the island?
